On behalf of the French Presidency of the PCC, we have the honour to invite you to the next PCC Conference with the topic :

« Valorisation of Digital Cadastral Data – Towards a More Sovereign, Effective, and Ecological European Model »

Paris, on the 31^h of May and 1st June 2022.

Co-organised by EuroGeographics CRLKEN and the French Public Finances General Directorate (DGFIP), the Conference will be held in Paris, in a hybrid format, both face-to-face and online.

Based on covid restrictions and sanitary conditions, the number of participants is limited to 50 in total, therefore EU, EFTA and EEA members are invited to attend by person and all other members are welcome to attend the event on-line.

The Conference will take place at the premises of the French Public Finances General Directorate, which is an annex of the Ministry of Economy, Finances, and The Recovery, located at 9 Place Saint-Sulpice in downtown Paris (75006).
