On behalf of the French presidency of the PCC, we are honoured to send you the official invitation to the Conference and Plenary Meeting of the PCC, which will be held 31st May and 1st June, 2022, in a hybrid format, both online and in Paris.

The topic of the conference will be “Valorisation of Digital Cadastral Data – Towards a More Sovereign, Effective, and Ecological European Model”. The registration is now open and can be accessed [here](#) on the website of EuroGeographics ; you will also find a draft agenda on the website.

Due to the pandemic regulations, the conference center can only host 50 participants in Paris ; therefore, EU, EFTA, and EEA members are invited to attend by person and all others will be able to follow the conference online.

In order to facilitate our practical organization in Paris, we encourage you to register as early as possible, preferably before 06th May.

The PCC will take place at the premises of the French Public Finances General Directorate, located at 9 Place Saint-Sulpice, in Paris (75006).

The conference will begin at 9:30 (registration at 9:00 on 31 May), breakfast and lunch will be provided at the conference center. We have also planned a dinner in the evening of 31 May.

Unfortunately, there is no agreement on accomodation with an hotel. The participants are expected to make their booking directly to the hotel of their choice.
