I wish to kindly invite you to take part in the Conference on "Cadastral, Public Policies and Economic Activity" on 1st-2nd June 2010 to be held in Madrid (Spain) on the occasion of the Spanish Cadastral PCC Presidency. This thematic workshop is focuses on paying attention to the European users of the Cadastre; to all the public bodies that use cadastral data, but especially to the private users and companies who in ever larger numbers re-utilize cadastral data and add value to their content.

Not only will we be watching out for the traditional users like the parties on the real estate market or in the fiscal sector, but also for new purposes of cadastral data related to national and European land policies.

A clear focus will be put principally on Pan-European users but on related national contexts as well since we are convinced that such as of now national users, will evolve to the Pan-European level in the near future.

The conference is limited to 120 people (cadastral organizations and users of all Europe). It is our intention to give preference to the PCC members so we will encourage you to register as soon as possible.

Also we will like to ask you to make good divulgation of this event to count with a large representation of all cadastral users of Europe.

The conference will precede the PCC plenary meeting that we will hold the afternoon of 2nd June. The agenda of this Plenary Meeting has not been yet defined but we have the intention to debate in detail how the future of the European Cadastral Organizations is directly related with the use given by the citizens and companies to their managed information, and also to reflect about the way in which States Member's Cadastres should relate themselves with the European institutions, in a way that can allow obtaining useful conclusions for our organisations' future.

We count already with the confirmed participation of EuroGeographics.
