With great pleasure we invite you to attend the Conference on "Cadastre, Public Policies and Economic Activity" to be held in Madrid in June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> 2010, on the occasion of the Spanish Cadastre Presidency of the Permanent Committee on Cadastre in the European Union.

The increasing availability of the cadastral data in Europe and the development of geographical digital technology has boost the public and private use of this data with multiply applications and it has also prompted interest in the cadastral parcel as an element in spatial data infrastructures (SDI's). In many cases, certainly within Europe, the parcel is the geographical object with the highest granularity.

Currently much geographical information is already registered based on cadastral parcel information and the use of this cadastral data is increasing in many other economical sectors, by public bodies, but especially by private users who in ever larger numbers re-utilize cadastral data and add value to their content.

For this reason on this occasion best practices in the field of the employment of cadastral data in Europe will be presented.

A clear focus will be put principally on Pan-European users but on related national contexts as well since we are convinced that such as of now national users, will evolve to the Pan-European level in the near future.

The conference is limited to 120 people (cadastral organizations and users of all Europe) so we ask you to register yourself as soon as possible.
