[The Estonian Land Board](#) has a great honour to assume the presidency of the Permanent Committee on Cadastre in the European Union (PCC) also for the first time. We are pleased to inform you to save the date for the PCC conference and plenary meeting "Towards Digital Europe and Spatially Enabled Societies" to be held **in Tallinn from 13 to 15 November 2017**.

The programme will start with an *ice-breaker* on Monday evening at the medieval Tallinn [Town Hall](#). The venue of the conference and plenary meeting will be the [Nordic Hotel Forum](#) (Viru väljak 3). The hotel is situated in the city centre, just a couple of hundred meters from the picturesque Old Town. The conference dinner will take place on Tuesday evening at the Maarjamäe Palace.
