Summary of the main points of the meeting:

1. Presentation of Berny Kersten from EuroGeographics who will be a big support for our team.
2. Martin Salzmann summarized the Discussion during meeting Eurogeographics Expert Group on Information and Data Specifications (Apeldoorn, The Netherlands January 30, 2007), the main points are:
 - *Core elements of the cadastral parcel*: implementation and the meaning of the parcel for INSPIRE.
 - *Modelling*: We were praised for our detailed and practical work. The IDS-group missed, however, a modelling effort. They actually feel that a conceptual model is needed covering at least parcel, address and building. Then the next step would be the implementing rules and we would focus on parcels and addresses (building being part of annex 3). Having a model available would secure the long-term sustainability of the relations between all entities.

After a lively and fruitful discussion we concluded:

That we will support the Drafting Teams of INSPIRE and the Team of Andreas Illert within EuroGeographics (ExG IDS), in all cases regarding the "cadastral parcel".

And, regarding the questions of the ExG IDS of modelling "addresses" and "buildings", could be summarized to the following: address and the building: link by geo-reference and not by explicit modelling .

4. The result of the main discussion on the 2nd questionnaire and the final report of our project is documented in the draft of the paper: "**The central role of the cadastral parcel in INSPIRE**"

 - Definition and inventory (1st questionnaire)
 - Inventory document
 - Why just 5 core elements (reference information-additional information)
 - Use of Cadastral parcel in NSDI (2nd questionnaire)
- **The Role of the cadastral parcel in INSPIRE – Conclusions**
- **The 5 core elements**: Relation to the other elements in Annexes and **Implementation issues**.
- And the Outlook on future developments.

5. The work plan (roadmap) of the project has to be adopted in the following:

- a. Berny Kersten drafts a 1st version in the next weeks
- b. Draft version of the report will be discussed at the next meeting: 7th/8th May 2007 in Hanover
- c. Update of the report
- d. Presentation of the (final?) report at the PCC-Meeting in Hamburg (13th/14th June 2007)
